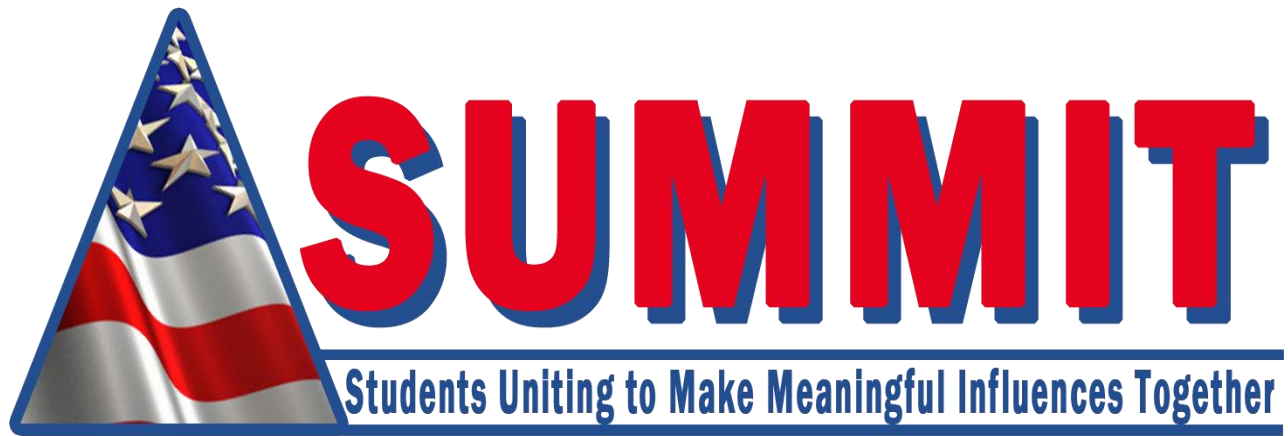

The dynamic duo is prepared to impact the lives of our audience with poetry, music, and their inspiring stories. Jeremy and Eddie bring high energy, inspiration, and life-changing experiences to impact you, “Sole to Soul.”

Jeremy brings 23 years of professional experience in youth development, mental health advocacy, and drug and alcohol prevention, in addition to the thousands of presentations he's given from prisons to prestigious universities. **This vast experience provides** Jeremy with the kind of knowledge-base and real-world experience you want to entrust your audience with.

“Raza” is an independent Hip Hop artist whose music comes from his life experiences with fatherlessness, abuse, homelessness, and addiction. As a young boy, he was removed from his parents due to their drug abuse and incarceration. Unfortunately, the family that adopted him was abusive too. Raza ran away and was emancipated at 15 years old.

Not having anyone to call family, and not knowing any other way, he too fell into addiction himself, which led him to a hospital bed fighting for his life. It was at that moment that RAZA found hope in the darkest place inside him. Now he uses his passion for music to perform and speak at juvenile halls letting everyone know that HOPE is always there even when you can't see it.
